At the site of the Middlesex Music Festival
1649 West Avenue Middlesex

At Caward Cross Road / West Avenue
(just a 10 minute drive from the center of Naples)

Tickets \$25 per person

(all tickets must be pre ordered / all sales final)

What to expect when you get there (besides a great show):

- The site will open for parking at 1 p.m. Please allow yourself enough time to park before 2 p.m.
- Please enter the site from Caward Cross Road (not from West Avenue).
- Parking attendants at the entrance to the site (Caward Cross Road at West Avenue) will check you in.
- Please do not roll down your window to check in. For a contact-free check-in, the attendant will check your license plate number and the number of passengers in your car through the window.
- After being checked in, follow the parking attendants instructions as they point you toward your personal parking/viewing area.
- Each car will have a parking space and a personal space next to their car to set up chairs, if you wish. This is your home base and, per NYS health and safety regulations, everyone in your party must remain in that area to view the concert.
- If you've never been to this site: it's a stage in a field. The terrain is not always level as it would be in a paved parking lot. Moving away from your designated parking area may prove difficult for anyone with mobility issues.
- Please do not join other patrons in their parking areas.
- If you or anyone in your party leaves your assigned space to use the bathroom or purchase water or other merchandise, a face covering must be worn over mouth and nose, and social distance from all others outside your party must be maintained.
- The show starts at 2 p.m. No late coming vehicles will be admitted until intermission.

How do I get a ticket?

All tickets must be purchased in advance by phone. No in person sales.

When you call for your ticket we will need

- Your name and phone number (for contact tracing)
- The names and phone numbers of everyone who will be in your vehicle (if they are riding in your vehicle but buying their own tickets, we can get their contact tracing info when then call to buy their ticket).
- All cars must have a minimum of 2 and maximum of 6 passengers.
- The make and model of your vehicle (trucks and larger SUVs will be directed to parking spaces behind smaller cars) and your license plate number.
- If you are buying a ticket, but will be in another person's vehicle, you only need to provide the name of the driver of your vehicle and we will get the make, model and license plate information from them.
- If you need to make changes (which vehicle you are driving or who is in your party) please call us by 5 p.m. on Sept. 11 to make any updates).
- Credit card sales preferred, but you may also send a check to BVT, PO Box 218, Naples, 14512. Tickets will not be held until payment is received.
- There will be no "walk up" or "drive up" sales. All ticket holders must arrive in a vehicle and all must have reservations and a prepaid ticket.

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Directions from the Theater:

Head northeast on S Main St toward Vine St for one mile. Turn right onto NY-245 N and continue for 7.3 miles Turn left onto Caward Cross Rd and in .2 miles you'll see our parking attendants who will guide you to your parking space!

Coming from the North:

Take NY RT 245 South through Middlesex. About 2 miles south of Middlesex you'll see Caward Cross Road on your right. Turn right on Caward Cross Rd. and in .2 miles you'll see our parking attendants who will guide you.



Please do not attend this event if you have been diagnosed with Covid -19, or have recently been exposed to someone who has been diagnosed. Do not attend if you are not feeling well, are running a fever or are exhibiting other symptoms. Thanks for keeping our community safe!

YES!

- If you purchased tickets to Sam and Aaron's cancelled Spring performance at BVT, and did not request a refund, you can attend this concert at no cost, but call and make your reservation.
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- Parking is first come first served. Larger vehicles will be directed to park behind the smaller vehicles.
- You can bring your own lawn chairs (just stay in your area).
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- You can bring your own food and drink (no alcoholic beverages, though...sorry!)
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- There will be water on sale (and BVT t-shirts and other merch!).
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- There will be portable bathrooms.
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- You should take all your trash, bottles and cans with you when you leave.
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- You should bring your own mask and wear it whenever you leave your parking area.
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- There will be hand sanitizing stations.
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- We have a rain date - September 19. Same start time, same location.
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- We are going to have a great time!!

NOPE!

- No pets
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- No 'walk up' or 'drive up' sales. Everyone must be in a vehicle and must have a reservation.
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- No alcoholic beverages--we said that before but... just a reminder.
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- No smoking (tobacco or marijuana).
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- No radios or other distracting noise making devices during the show.
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- Don't leave your car running once you are in your parking area.
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- No gathering or merging of groups. Stay in your designated parking/viewing area.
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- There will be no snacks on sale (you'll bring better ones anyway!)
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- There will be no chairs provided. You may sit in your car or bring your own lawn chairs.
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- No cars will be admitted after the music starts.
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- No BVT comp passes will be accepted for this event.
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- No refunds. No exceptions.

The health and safety of our community, *including you*, is our #1 priority. Anyone not following health and social distancing guidelines will be asked to leave the event, without a refund.
